



## Create It Exhibition – Adult Art

Autumn Fest – Saturday 17 May 2025

### General rules for conduct of Autumn Fest exhibitors

1. Entry forms are available at [www.stdavidsnc.org.au](http://www.stdavidsnc.org.au) or by emailing [info@stdavidsnc.org.au](mailto:info@stdavidsnc.org.au) or can be picked up St David's Neighbourhood Centre, 68 Orange Grove Road, Coopers Plains from 1 May 2025.
2. All exhibitors must present their exhibits for judging by the appointed time and place. Officials reserve the right to change exhibitions to the correct class or disqualify if the entry does not meet the criteria.
3. The Judges decision in any section will be final.
4. Ribbons and certificates will be awarded at the Judge's discretion.
5. Whilst all reasonable care is taken, St David's Neighbourhood Centre cannot accept responsibility for any losses or damage to exhibits or any other property whilst on St David's Neighbourhood Centre premises.
6. In the event of a dispute arising from the Rules or any other aspect of the exhibit, the decision of St David's Neighbourhood Manager or Manager's nominee shall be final, and the process of reaching a decision shall be in the absolute discretion of the Manager or Manager's nominee.

### Conditions of Entry

1. All exhibits to be delivered to St David's Neighbourhood Centre. Entries can be received from Monday 12 May 2025 to Wednesday 14 May 2025 between the hours of 9.00 am – 3.00 pm.
2. All entries must be received with a completed entry form. Each entrant must have a separate entry form.
3. Entry to exhibit is free.
4. Dimensions:
  - a. Artwork: no greater than 1m<sup>2</sup> including frame.
  - b. 3D items: no greater than 300 mm in any direction.
5. All exhibits must be the unassisted work of the entrant and have been completed in the last 3 years.
6. Entries cannot be created using 3D printing technology.
7. Exhibits to be in 'as new' unwashed condition, soiled work is not accepted.
8. Exhibits cannot be entered for, nor compete in, more than one Class.
9. Entries are to be labelled:
  - a. Back of all entries: exhibitor's name and phone number
  - b. Front of all entries: the label from the entry form
10. All framed pieces must have a secure hanging device. D's x 2 or similar must be screwed or nailed to the frame with a suitable cord/wire
11. If 'For Sale,' exhibits must be marked with a price.
12. Late entries or wet art will not be accepted.
13. Adult entries will be received for those 18+ as of 1 May 2025



**Create It Exhibition – Entry Categories**

- Class 1            Painting – any medium – landscape
- Class 2            Painting – any medium – still life
- Class 3            Painting – any medium – any other subject
- Class 4            Drawing – any medium – any subject
- Class 5            3D item – any medium including collage

**Collection of Exhibits:** Entries can be collected at the conclusion of Autumn Fest, after 1.00 pm on Saturday 17 May 2024 or on Monday 19 May 2025. Any exhibits not collected by 3.00 pm on Monday 19 May 2025 will remain the property of St David’s Neighbourhood Centre.
