General rules for conduct of Autumn Fest exhibitors

1. Entry forms are available at www.stdavidsnc.org.au or by emailing info@stdavidsnc.org.au or can be picked up St David's Neighbourhood Centre, 68 Orange Grove Road, Coopers Plains from 1 May 2025.
2. All exhibitors must present their exhibits for judging by the appointed time and place. Officials reserve the right to change exhibitions to the correct class or disqualify if the entry does not meet the criteria.
3. The Judges decision in any section will be final.
4. Ribbons and certificates will be awarded at the Judge's discretion.
5. Whilst all reasonable care is taken, St David's Neighbourhood Centre cannot accept responsibility for any losses or damage to exhibits or any other property whilst on St David's Neighbourhood Centre premisses.
6. In the event of a dispute arising from the Rules or any other aspect of the exhibit, the decision of St David's Neighbourhood Manager or Manager's nominee shall be final, and the process of reaching a decision shall be in the absolute discretion of the Manager or Manager's nominee.

Conditions of Entry

1. All exhibits to be delivered to St David's Neighbourhood Centre. Entries can be received from Monday 12 May 2025 to Wednesday 14 May 2025 between the hours of 9.00 am – 3.00 pm.
2. All entries must be received with a completed entry form. Each entry must have a separate entry form.
3. Entry to exhibit is free.
4. All entries must be the child's unaided work & completed in the last 12 months.
5. Work done under instruction in art/craft class are not accepted.
6. Dimensions:
 - a. Artwork: no greater than 1m² including frame.
 - b. 3D items: no greater than 300 mm in any direction.
7. All exhibits must be the unassisted work of the entrant and have been completed in the last 12 months.
8. Entries cannot be created using 3D printing technology.
9. Exhibits cannot be entered for, nor compete in, more than one Class.
10. Entries are to be labelled:
 - a. Back of all entries: Child's name, date of birth and phone number
 - b. Front of all entries: Entry Class and child's age as of 1 May 2025
11. All artworks must be mounted with a hanging device (stiff cardboard accepted).
12. Late entries or wet art will not be accepted.

7 – 8 years as of 1 May 2025

- Class 9 Painting – any medium

- Class 11 3D Item – any medium including collage

9 – 11 years as of 1 May 2025

- Class 12 Painting – any medium
- Class 13 Drawing – any medium
- Class 14 3D Item – any medium including collage

12 – 14 years as of 1 May 2025

- Class 15 Painting – any medium
- Class 16 Drawing – any medium
- Class 17 3D Item – any medium including collage

15 – 17 years as of 1 May 2025

- Class 18 Painting – any medium
- Class 19 Drawing – any medium
- Class 20 3D Item – any medium including collage
